To give someone a hand	Jemandem helfen	Can you give me a hand with this email?
To have a hand in something	An irgendwas teilnehmen,	The report sounds great. Did Ben have a hand in it?
To hand somebody something	Jemandem etwas reichen	Can you hand me that folder please?
To gain the upper hand	Die Oberhand gewinnen	After his great interview the politician started to gain the upper hand in the polls
To hand it to someone	Jemanden bewundern	You've got to hand it to Michaela; she gave a really great presentation.
To have your hands full	Sehr beschäftigt sein	I'd love to help but I've got my hands full with the customer meeting this week.
To have your hands tied	Machtlos sein, nicht agieren können	If it were up to me I would fire him, but my hands are tied.
To hand something over	Jemanden etwas geben; die Verantwortung für etwas übergeben	I'm not in charge of the project anymore. I handed it over to Sarah last month.
