To give someone the cold shoulder	Jemanden ignorieren, unfreundlich sein	I asked him if we could have a meeting but he gave me the cold shoulder.
To shoulder the blame	Die Schuld für irgendwas tragen	It was her mistake and she needs to shoulder the blame for it.
The hard shoulder	Der Standstreifen	The tyre blew, but the driver managed to pull over and stop on the hard shoulder.
A shoulder to cry on	Trost und Unterstützung	Andy is a good friend. He gave me a shoulder to cry on when my cat died.
To have a chip on your shoulder	Noch wütend sein, wenn man das Gefühl hat, man wurde in der Vergangenheit unfair behandelt	She wasn't very helpful. I think she's still got a chip on her shoulder about that time I got a pay rise and she didn't.
To put your shoulder to the wheel	Sich Mühe geben	The deadline's tomorrow. We'll really have to put our shoulders to the wheel if we want to be finished on time.
To have a good head on your shoulders	Schlau sein, gute Entscheidungen treffen können	I'm sure she'll be a great team leader – she has a good head on her shoulders.
To have broad shoulders	Schwieriges schaffen können	There's a lot going on at the moment but he can handle it – he has broad shoulders.
