Ausdruck	Bedeutung	Beispiel
Without batting an eye	Ohne abgelenkt oder überfordert zu werden	She gave a talk in front of 150 people without batting an eye.
To keep an eye out for something	Aufpassen, nach irgendwas Ausschau halten	This is a nice lake, but you need to keep an eye out for mosquitoes.
Keep your eye on the ball	Fokussiert bleiben	If you want to pass those exams you'll have to keep your eye on the ball.
Your eyes are bigger than your stomach	Du denkst, du kannst mehr essen als eigentlich geht	I can't finish this pasta – I think my eyes were bigger than my stomach.
To turn a blind eye	Irgendwas ignorieren	The police knew she'd done it, but they turned a blind eye because she was famous
To be in the public eye	In der Öffentlichkeit sein, wo dich jeder beobachten kann	Politicians are very much in the public eye and should be careful about what they say and do.
To catch someone's eye	Die Aufmerksamkeit auf sich ziehen	If I can catch the waiter's eye we can pay the bill and go home.
To have eagle eyes	Kleinigkeiten gut sehen/finden können	Let Jane do the proofreading. She's good at finding errors with her eagle eyes.
